Students will receive an Acceptance Letter following thorough document review and approval.

ELECTRONIC REGISTRATION

Students whose official nominations have been approved will receive an email containing a username and password to register on the UG electronic platform: https://intraug.ugto.mx/. It is essential for students to finalize their registration by April 27, 2026.

ASSIGNMENT TO A RESEARCH GROUP

As of May 15, 2026, students who have successfully finished their electronic registration may join a professor's research team at the University of Guanajuato, allocated based on their preferred field of study as indicated in the recommendation letter from a professor and a statement of intent. This information will be communicated to each student via email.
